- **Emerging Issues in Water Treatment-** *This one-day course provides water treatment professionals with up-to-date knowledge on emerging contaminants and issues that impact drinking water safety. Participants will explore new contaminants, evolving regulations, and treatment processes to address these challenges in water management. Topics covered:*
 - Overview of microbiological contaminants, including bacteria, viruses, and parasites
 - Disinfection by-products (DBPs) and their health implications
 - Chemical contaminants, such as PFAS and heavy metals
 - Pharmaceuticals, personal care products (PPCPs), and endocrine-disrupting compounds (EDCs)
 - Climate change and its impact on water sources and treatment processes
 - New regulatory changes affecting water treatment standards

This course is ideal for water treatment operators and professionals responsible for adapting treatment protocols to address the latest public health concerns and regulatory requirements in water quality management.

- **Drinking Water Distribution Systems Training-** *This training course teaches operators the key skills they need to understand, maintain, and troubleshoot drinking water distribution systems.*
 - How the system is laid out,
 - Types of pipes and valves used,
 - How pumps and storage tanks work,
 - How pressure is managed, and
 - How to protect water quality and prevent contamination.
 - Participants learn through hands-on activities, simple calculations, visual demonstrations, and group discussions that make the ideas easier to understand.

The course also helps operators prepare for certification exams and gives useful training for technicians, supervisors, and maintenance staff.
