- **Chlorine Disinfection Benefits, Risks and Alternatives** - *This one-day course will introduce students to trihalomethanes, haloacetic acids, chlorination, contact time, chloramination and alternative treatments for the disinfection of drinking water. Topics covered:*
  - *Why drinking water needs to be disinfected and the chemistry, benefits and risks of disinfection*
  - *Introduce criteria for disinfectant alternatives including ozone, ultraviolet, chlorine dioxide and hypochlorites*
  - *Look at disinfectant applications and control, the difference and similarities between chlorine and chloramines and available disinfection treatment alternatives*
  - *methods to calculate the minimum required contact time (CT) for inactivation of bacteria, viruses and microorganisms in drinking water*

*This course is tailored for water treatment operators.*

- **Winter Wise: The Cold Hard Facts about Distribution Systems** - *This course provides vital training on managing and maintaining water distribution systems during cold weather conditions. Participants will learn strategies to prevent, mitigate, and repair damage caused by freezing temperatures. Topics covered:*
  - *Properties of water and its behavior in cold temperatures*
  - *Frost penetration and its impact on water mains*
  - *Preventing winter damage to water infrastructure*
  - *Thawing methods for hydrants, valves, and water services*
  - *Winterizing fire hydrants and maintaining auto flushers*
  - *Winter safety and cold stress management*

*This course is ideal for water distribution professionals responsible for ensuring system reliability in freezing conditions.*
