  - Why drinking water needs to be disinfected and the chemistry, benefits and risks of disinfection
  - o Introduce criteria for disinfectant alternatives including ozone, ultraviolet, chlorine dioxide and hypochlorites
  - Look at disinfectant applications and control, the difference and similarities between chlorine and chloramines and available disinfection treatment alternatives
  - methods to calculate the minimum required contact time (CT) for inactivation of bacteria, viruses and microorganisms in drinking water

  - Winter safety and cold stress management
