Application Guidelines

- 1. Entry must be received electronically by May 31, 2020.
- 2. Each entry shall be composed of the following:
 - Title of Project with 100-word summary
 - Executive Summary
 - Background
 - Detailed description of the program and its results
- 3. Where possible, data should be quantitative.
- 4. Each entry must contain a signature from an official of the organization, certifying the validity of the information provided in the report, and agreeing that it may be shared and posted on the OWWA website.
- 5. Each entry shall include a contact name, address, phone number and email address.
- 6. Entries shall be a maximum of 7 pages.
- 7. Updated entries may be resubmitted in subsequent years.

Submission Criteria

Judges will determine the most appropriate award category for each application.

Submissions are evaluated using the following criteria:

- 1. Innovation/creativity
- 2. Clearly defined goals, objectives, timelines
- 3. Quantified water/wastewater savings and financial results
- 4. Public or staff education results
- 5. Technical merits
- 6. Transferability to other Ontario organizations
- 7. Quality of submission

Award Presentation

The awards will be presented by the OWWA to the winners at their respective offices. A wall plaque will be presented to each winner.

Award submissions and winners will also be reported in Pipeline, the quarterly publication of the OWWA, OMWA & OWWEA which is distributed to water and wastewater professionals across Ontario.
