MSF is carrying activities in over 80 countries, employing around 45,000 people worldwide.

MAIN PURPOSE

As a water and sanitation specialist working with Doctors Without Borders/Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF), you can help ensure access to lifesaving healthcare for people in need. Our water and sanitation experts design and manage water and sanitation projects in addition to supervising and training staff.

Water and sanitation specialists must have formal training or extensive work experience in the specialty. Water projects can range from drilling bore wells in remote areas to setting up clean water sources in a refugee camp or managing the emergency provision of drinking water after a natural disaster. Sanitation work can involve building latrines or taking care of waste management in a hospital.

REQUIREMENTS

- Degree or education in civil, geological, mechanical or environmental engineering with an emphasis on surface water, underground water, treatment, distribution and discharge
- Two years of professional experience in water and sanitation (e.g., water, hygiene, waste management, sanitation, vector control)
- Strong command of French and English
- Available to work a minimum of 6 months with the ambition to sign up for multiple assignments
- Experience supervising, training and coaching others
- International travel or work experience in conditions and circumstances relevant to the work of MSF

ASSETS

- Proficiency with Microsoft Office software
- Knowledge or experience in the treatment of medical waste and vector control in medical settings

- Knowledge of other languages such as Arabic and Spanish,
- Strong teamwork skills
- Flexibility and openness to working in different countries and (unstable) contexts

WHAT WE OFFER

- Pre-departure training through a combination of e-learning, face-to-face meetings and workshops, as well as additional training and professional development opportunities throughout an MSF career
- Reimbursement of required vaccinations and related medical fees
- Required visas and work permits
- Accommodation and round-trip transportation to and from the field as well as travel costs for briefings and debriefings
- Daily compensation in local currency paid while in the field for coverage of basic expenses. This varies in amount depending on country and context.
- Medical, disability and life insurance coverage
