
Job Description

Qualifications:

- Water and wastewater treatment certification, minimum Class 2
- 10 years of water/wastewater operating experience, preferably in small water/wastewater systems
- Strong mechanical and electrical skills, preferably accompanied by a trade designation/certification

Responsibilities:

- Provide 24/7 technical support and first response "on-call" services to Ontario's First Nation communities
- Coordinate and provide on-site responses to 24/7 technical support and first response requests for emergency assistance
- Coordinate and complete minor and major capital improvements to First Nation water and wastewater treatment systems
- Provide water/wastewater operator relief coverage in remote First Nation communities

Other Details:

- The position includes on-call standby responsibilities
- The position requires extensive travel to remote (air access only) First Nation communities
- The position is physically demanding and may require work in harsh environmental conditions (ie. cold weather)
- The position is likely to have irregular work schedules and/or extended hours of work
- The position allows for the candidate to live anywhere in Northwestern Ontario, from Thunder Bay to Kenora.
