Evaluate trends and identify visual and audible abnormalities to determine process performance.

Take appropriate corrective action to address incidents of non-compliance and deviations from design objectives.

Identify and propose improvements to operational plans, procedures, workflow processes and infrastructure.

Review internal and external facility testing results and determine treatment efficiency, identify potential process issues and administer the appropriate operational changes. Conduct routine maintenance checks on facility equipment and notify appropriate stakeholders of issues or required repairs.

Comply with all health and safety requirements, maintain a safe work environment, report hazards and promote a culture of safety in the workplace.
