This position works in a team environment along side other environmental specialists in the formulation of short- and long-term water quality workplans, budgets, policy analysis and development, and related business plans and initiatives. The Manager, Water Quality works with technical staff to deliver the programs and provides water quality expertise on City projects, as required, in conjunction with other City Project/Program Managers.
