Reporting to the Supervisor, Water Distribution, the successful applicant for this position will be responsible for maintaining and operating the water distribution system in accordance with the Ministry of the Environment, Conservation and Parks (MOECP) specifications and stakeholder interests. The duties include but are not limited to performing preventative maintenance and emergency repair activities on all appurtenances within the water distribution system; planning, initiating and tearing down traffic plans and devices in accordance with MTO, MOL, City of Windsor regulations and ENWIN policy; performing inspection on customer equipment and direction ensuring work is performed in accordance with ENWIN standards; troubleshooting and responding to customer complaints; commissioning new infrastructure; hot tapping of distribution system for the addition of new services, pressure stations and maintaining the water distribution system throughout the ENWIN network; troubleshooting and diagnostics on the water distribution network; water meter changes on ENWIN's water distribution system completing all company required documentation accurately and submitting them in a timely manner.

The successful candidate will be expected to meet a minimum standard which includes successful attainment of the Water Distribution Subsystem Class 1 Certificate. Duties will become progressively greater with each phase of practical experience and training. Progression within the classification will depend on satisfactory performance on the job and successful completion of the Water Distribution Operator apprenticeship training objectives.
