Reporting to the Supervisor of Construction, the Construction Inspector/Operator is responsible for the inspection of City Capital Construction projects as well as Development projects as required. The Construction Inspector / Operator will work closely with the Project Coordinator assigned to each Capital Construction Project. Other duties include:

- Responsible to ensure that all Contractors adhere to City Specifications and Standard Drawings, document all construction activities in a daily diary, record quantities and measurements for all road and underground services.
- Complete all forms and red line drawings for "As-Construction" drawings in a timely matter.
- Will be required to turn valves and operate hydrants on local watermains within the construction project for the purposes of the completion of water connections between the new watermain and the existing water distribution system.
- Required to complete all DWQMS forms. Liaise with residents and businesses on the construction or development project.
- Provide weekly sketches of the watermains and valving changes on the projects to the Water Distribution and Wastewater Collection staff.
- Complete final inspections on all projects and report on any remaining deficiencies.
- Complete other duties as assigned.
