The Maintenance Operator WTP will also be required to perform various laboratory, maintenance, clerical, customer service and dispatches as required. Graduate of a 2-year community college program or equivalent. Water Treatment Operator Class 2 Certificate of Competency (including successful passing of exams) under the Ministry of Ontario O. Reg 128/04 (Operator Licencing). Operator in Training Certificate of Competency in Wastewater Treatment, Wastewater Collection and Water Distribution is required. Valid Millright certification considered an asset.
